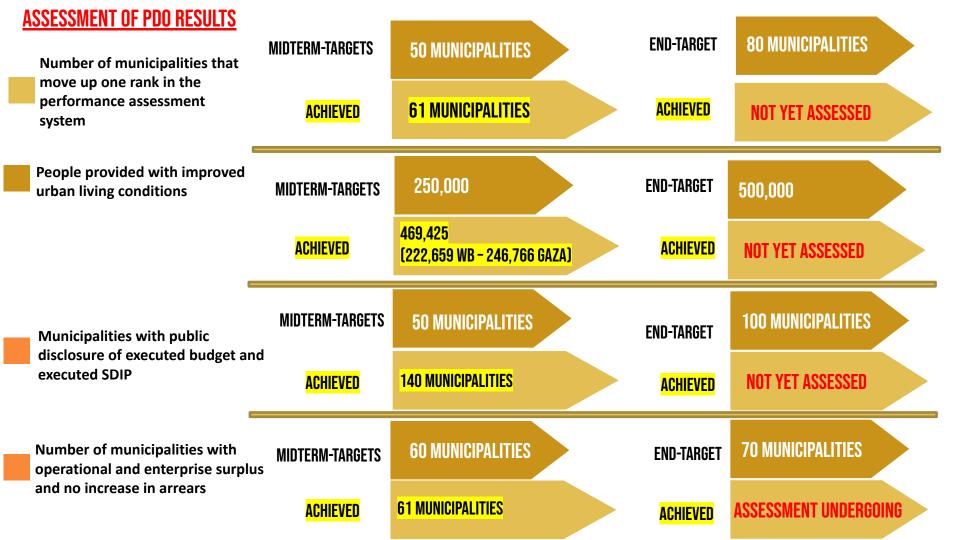

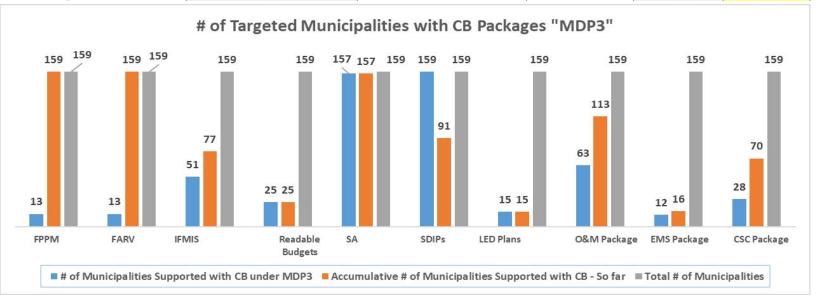

**Updated Policy Note for PPP**
